The committee works actively to ensure that the campus remains free from any form of ragging and that every student can pursue their academic journey in a secure and supportive atmosphere.

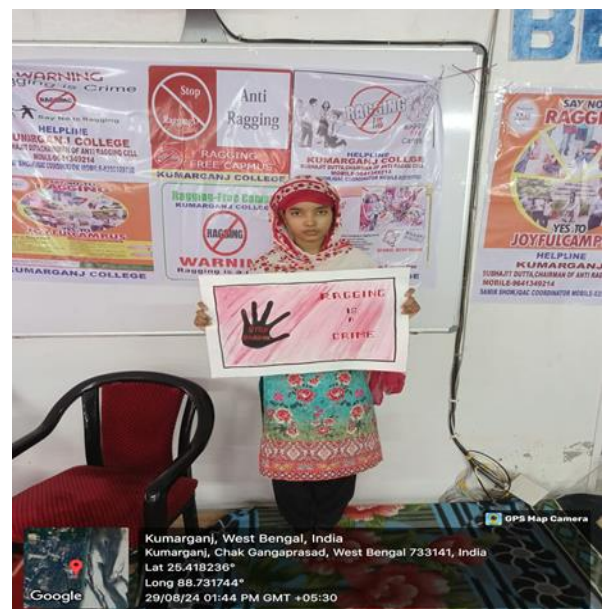

Every year in the month of **August**, the college observes **World Anti-Ragging Day** on the campus to raise awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging and to promote a culture of respect and harmony.



Objectives of the Anti-Ragging Committee

- To ensure a ragging-free campus environment
- To create awareness among students about the harmful consequences of ragging
- To educate students on how to identify and report ragging activities
- To encourage students to maintain mutual respect and harmony on campus
- To guide students in submitting the Anti-Ragging affidavit through the UGC portal



Activities and Awareness Programs

- Awareness sessions and orientation programs for new students
- Poster, slogan, and essay writing competitions on anti-ragging themes
- Display of anti-ragging posters and notices across the campus
- Student participation in rallies and awareness campaigns
- Cultural activities and street plays conveying anti-ragging messages



Preventive Measures

- Mandatory submission of Anti-Ragging affidavits by students and their parents during admission
- Display of anti-ragging laws and guidelines at important locations in the college
- Regular monitoring of the campus by faculty members and committee representatives
- Periodic meetings of the Anti-Ragging Committee to review preventive measures
- Immediate investigation of any complaint related to ragging

UGC Anti-Ragging Guidelines

The college strictly follows the anti-ragging regulations issued by the **University Grants Commission (UGC)** to ensure a safe and respectful environment for all students.

According to the UGC guidelines:

- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the campus and in all activities related to the institution.

- Students and their parents are required to submit Anti-Ragging affidavits at the time of admission.
- The institution maintains an active Anti-Ragging Committee to monitor and prevent ragging incidents.

A STUDENT INDULGING IN RAGGING CAN BE:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Withholding/withdrawing Scholarship/Fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament or youth festival etc.
- Collective punishment : when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on potential ragger.
